Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach the organiser not later than: **July 13<sup>th</sup> 2009 at midnight**. Later applications will only accepted if there is place in the concerning class.

The organiser will select the applications and advice riders within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or rejected.

The entry fee is: € 200,-- for the whole event and should be paid before the event starts.

Riders must have UEM One-Event Promosport licence of 2009.

## **14.PRIZES**

Directly **after the end of each race**, the first three qualified riders will be awarded with prizes at the podium.

## **15.FINAL PRIZE GIVING**

3/4 Hour after the last race on Sunday, the Final Price giving for the European Championship standings will be at the Podium.

## **16.PROTEST**

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the UEM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of: €. 130,00.

## 17. FUEL

There will be no fuel supplied by the organiser in the paddock. It must be in conformity with Article RR06.2.9 of the UEM Technical Rules Pocketbikes.

## **18. INSURANCE**

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements.

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

# **19. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES**

Apart from the requirements of the UEM Sporting Code, riders and passengers by participating, renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the UEM Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to arising out of their actions.
